

**SENATE BILL No. 532**

1 AN ACT concerning elections; relating to candidate names on ballots;  
2 allowing candidates for nonpartisan office to have such candidate's  
3 political party provided with such candidate's name; amending K.S.A.  
4 25-613 and repealing the existing section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 25-613 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-  
8 613. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the name of each  
9 candidate shall be printed on the ballot only once and no name that is  
10 printed on the ballot shall be written elsewhere on the ballot. If a person is  
11 a candidate for the unexpired term for an office such person's name may be  
12 printed on the same ballot as a candidate of the same political party for the  
13 next regular term for such office. Also, a person may be an independent  
14 candidate for the unexpired term for an office and an independent  
15 candidate for the next regular term for such office, and the person's name  
16 may be printed for both candidacies on the same official general ballot.

17 (b) To the name of each candidate for a state office shall be added the  
18 name of the city in which the candidate resides. To the names of pairs of  
19 candidates running for governor and lieutenant governor shall be added the  
20 name of the city in which or near which each resides.

21 (c) To the name of each candidate for any national, state, county or  
22 township offices shall be added the person's political party or political  
23 designation in accordance with the nomination papers of the person. *A*  
24 *candidate for any office other than a national, state, county or township*  
25 *office may elect to have such candidate's political party or political*  
26 *designation added to such candidate's name. Any ordinance, resolution or*  
27 *regulation adopted by a city, county, township, school district or any other*  
28 *political subdivision of this state, including, but not limited to, any*  
29 *ordinance, resolution or regulation adopted on or before July 1, 2022, that*  
30 *is in direct conflict with the provisions of this subsection shall be null and*  
31 *void.*

32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-613 is hereby repealed.

33 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
34 publication in the statute book.
