SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2214

As Recommended by House Committee on
Appropriations

Brief*

HB 2214 would authorize the Secretary of Administration, on behalf on the Department of Corrections, to convey real estate adjacent to the site of the former Beloit Juvenile Correctional Facility to the City of Beloit. All costs related to the conveyance would be paid by the City of Beloit.

Background

The bill was introduced by Representative Concannon on February 3, 2021.

House Committee on Appropriations

In the House Committee on Appropriations hearing on February 16, 2021, Representative Concannon and representatives of the City of Beloit and the Department of Corrections provided **proponent** testimony. Proponents generally indicated this 6.38-acre tract of land was inadvertently omitted when the former Beloit Juvenile Correctional Facility was transferred to the City of Beloit in 2010 (KSA 76-2221). The State granted the city easement to the property in 1964 for construction of a water tower. The proponent testimony indicated recent plans to develop a sports complex resulted in a title search revealing the property continued to be owned by the Department of Corrections.
