**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 2492**

As Recommended by Senate Committee on
Ways and Means

Brief*

Senate Sub. for HB 2492 would reconcile amendments to statutes that were amended more than once during the current and prior legislative sessions. For such statutes, the bill would repeal one version and, if necessary, amend the continuing version with noncontradictory amendments, creating a single version of the statute containing all amendments.

Background

HB 2492 was introduced by the House Committee on Appropriations. As introduced, recommended by the House Committee, and passed by the House, the bill would have authorized expenditures and made appropriations in FY 2022 to pay claims against the State.

Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In the Senate Committee hearing on April 26, 2022, there were no conferees.

The Senate Committee recommended a substitute bill containing the contents of SB 578, which would reconcile amendments to statutes.

SB 578 (Reconciliation Bill)

SB 578 was introduced on April 26, 2022, by the Senate Committee on Ways and Means. [*Note:* The Office of Revisor of Statutes submits a bill of this type annually to reconcile and consolidate conflicting versions of statutes.]
