While I like the premise of the bill, I read it as saying that all advance ballots must be received by 7:00 pm on the second day preceding the date of election. With that said, it appears that you will not be able to drop off an advance ballot at your local polling location on the day of election. While I oppose all early mail-in voting, I feel if it is still offered, then you should be able to drop your ballot off at a polling location until the polls close at 7:00 pm on voting day. I think any other way causes confusion. I would suggest saying all advance ballot must be received in the election office or polling location by 7:00 pm on the day of the election.
