

HB2084 Brief

HB2084 would enact the kratom consumer protection act. The act contains six definitions including: food, kratom extract, kratom product, processor, retailer and secretary.

The bill prohibits a processor from:

1. Preparing, distributing or selling kratom product that is adulterated; contaminated, certain levels of residual solvents, a product containing a level of 7-hydroxymitragynine in the alkaloid fraction greater than 1%, a product containing synthetic alkaloids or a product without labeling directions, serving size and name and address of the manufacturer; or
2. Selling a product to a person under 18 years of age.

The bill makes it a civil penalty to violate the law not to exceed \$1,000 for a first offense and not to exceed \$2,000 for second and subsequent offenses. A hearing may be requested under the administrative procedure act.

The secretary of agriculture is required to adopt rules and regulations.
