

HB 2438 Brief

HB 2438 would eliminate the occupational license for instructor-coordinator and remove its reference throughout the statutes. The bill would remove the requirement that a member of the Board of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) must be an instructor-coordinator and instead would require a member to be actively involved in teaching initial courses of instruction for certification as an emergency medical services provider.
