Overview: AFIS technology has been used by the KBI since 1987, with the last update to the system in 2012. Fingerprint capture is done in 105 counties connected to the KBI AFIS. This system supports Courts, Law Enforcement, Civil Employers, and other Government agencies.



Project Scope: Replace the legacy AFIS technology with modern technology for Automatic Biometric Identification System (ABIS).
