Dear Honorable Chair Thompson and Members of the Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs,

I am submitting my testimony in favor of SB 366, to prohibit the mailing of advance voting ballot applications to voters, with the exception of a county election official “pursuant to a request by the voter.”

From my personal experience, I have often received a number of advance voting ballot applications in election years when I was not planning to vote in advance, but in person on Election Day.

I am not only concerned about the possible fraud implications, but also the wasted unnecessary costs including the paper, postal mailing and resources, all associated with multiple advance voting ballots.
