

**APPROVED PATHWAY:**

- Includes a minimum of three secondary-level credits.
- Includes a work-based element.
- Consist of a sequence:
  - Introductory-level course.
  - Technical-level course.
  - Application-level course.
- Supporting documentation includes:
  - Articulation Agreement(s).
  - Certification.
  - Program Improvement Plan.
  - Program of Study.
- Technical-level and Application-level courses receive.5 state weighted funding in an approved CTE pathway.

| <b>C</b>    | <b>Yes</b>                   | <b>Yes</b>          | <b>Yes</b>           |

L - Any course from the Excel in CTE list that is selected in an approved Pathway.  
High school and college credit is earned

C - All technical and application-level courses in an approved Pathway that are not on the Excel in CTE list. Courses earn both high school and college credit.  
Typically, students or district pay tuition for the course.
