
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2260 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2260 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2260 would amend the Medical Student Loan Act by increasing the number of psychiatry students who may enter into medical student loan agreements from six to 12 students. The bill would also prohibit the University of Kansas School of Medicine from creating any substantial impediment to students switching between approved postgraduate resident training programs.

The University of Kansas Medical Center indicates the enactment of HB 2260 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
