
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2291 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2291 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2291 would allow dogs on the premises of microbreweries if certain conditions are met. An establishment would be required to prepare, publicly post, and train its employees on procedures to prevent food contamination from dogs. Customers would be required to have their dogs under control while on the premises and would be prohibited from watering or feeding their dogs from the establishment's dishes or utensils.

The Kansas Department of Agriculture indicates that enactment of HB 2291 would not have a fiscal effect on agency operations.
