SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2438 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2438 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2438 would eliminate the occupational license for instructor-coordinator and remove its reference throughout statute. The bill would remove the requirement that a member of the Board of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) must be an instructor-coordinator and instead would require a member to be actively involved in teaching initial courses of instruction for certification as an emergency medical services provider.

The Board of EMS indicates enactment of the bill would reduce revenues to the EMS Operating Fund by \$2,700 in FY 2024. The Board estimates 77 instructor-coordinators would be due for renewal in FY 2024, which would generate \$2,310 in revenue from the \$30 renewal fee (77 applicants X \$30 renewal fee). In addition, an estimated six instructor-coordinators would be seeking initial certification in FY 2024, which would generate \$390 in revenue from the \$65 application fee (6 applicants X \$65 application fee). The Board states that eliminating the instructor-coordinator certification would reduce revenue from these applicants by \$2,700. The

Board notes that eliminating the instructor-coordinator certification could result in additional EMS classes being taught and a higher number of individuals seeking an occupational license as an emergency medical responder, emergency medical technician, advanced emergency medical technician, or paramedic. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2438 is not reflected in *The FY 2024 Governor's Budget Report*.
