SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 210 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 210 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 210 would allow candidates for nonpartisan offices to have their political party printed with the candidate's name on the ballot. Any ordinance or resolution adopted on or after July 1, 2023, that was in direct conflict with the bill would be null and void.

The Secretary of State indicates it would implement SB 210 using existing resources. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 210 is not reflected in *The FY 2024 Governor's Budget Report*.

The Kansas Association of Counties states SB 210 would not have a fiscal effect on the counties.
