1 AN ACT concerning elections; relating to voter registration; requiring 2 verification of the residential address for each registered voter; creating 3 the crime of falsifying a residential address for purposes of voter 4 registration; amending K.S.A. 25-2305a and repealing the existing 5 section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

8 Section 1. K.S.A. 25-2305a is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-9 2305a. (a) The county election officer shall record and maintain a 10 residential address and a mailing address for each registered voter if the 11 mailing address is different from the residential address. The residential 12 address of a registered voter shall correspond to a physical location where 13 the registered voter resides and shall not be a post office box or other 14 address that does not correspond to a physical location that can be occupied and, if not, the person shall not be considered a validly registered 15 16 voter.

(b) Upon recording a residential address or a change in residential
address for a registered voter, the county election officer shall verify that
such residential address satisfies the requirements of subsection (a).

20 (c) If the voter's residence corresponds to a physical location but no 21 residential address is provided, the voter shall provide the reason the voter 22 has no residential address, and the county election officer shall record 23 such reason.

(d) The county election officer shall record-such all information
 required under this section in any electronic database.

(e) (1) Falsifying a residential address for purposes of voter
registration is knowingly providing a residential address to a county
election officer for the purpose of registering to vote in such county when
such residential address does not correspond to the actual residence of the
registered voter.

31 (2) Falsifying a residential address for purposes of voter registration
32 is a severity level 9, nonperson felony.

33 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-2305a is hereby repealed.
