Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), no government official or employee of any state agency, county or city shall enter or remain on private property unless:

- (1) Authorized pursuant to a lawfully issued search warrant, court order, subpoena or the constitution of the United States; or
 - (2) the owner of such property has given written consent.
