1 AN ACT concerning health and healthcare; relating to ~~patient~~ **{licensed}**
2 care facilities; prohibiting the state fire marshal and the marshal's
3 representatives from wearing or operating a body camera during an on-
4 site inspection at a ~~patient~~ **{licensed}** care facility.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. (a) The state fire marshal and any of the marshal's
8 representatives shall not wear or operate a body camera or other audio or
9 video recording device during an on-site inspection of a ~~patient~~ **{licensed}**
10 care facility **or community-based locations where individuals with**
11 **intellectual and developmental disabilities receive individually**
12 **planned habilitation services as provided in K.S.A. 39-1804, and**
13 **amendments thereto.**

14 (b) As used in this section:

15 (1) "Body camera" means the same as defined in K.S.A. 45-254, and
16 amendments thereto; and

17 (2) "~~patient~~**{licensed}** care facility" includes—~~any~~ a **{child care**
18 **facility as defined in K.S.A. 65-503, and amendments thereto, }**
19 **qualified residential treatment program as defined in K.S.A. 38-2202,**
20 **and amendments thereto, a psychiatric residential treatment facility as**
21 **defined in K.S.A. 39-2002, and amendments thereto, secure facilities**
22 **as defined in K.S.A. 38-2202, and amendments thereto, shelter**
23 **facilities as defined in K.S.A. 38-2202, and amendments thereto, youth**
24 **residential facilities as defined in K.S.A. 38-2202, and amendments**
25 **thereto, an adult care home as defined in K.S.A. 39-923, and amendments**
26 **thereto, and**~~any~~ a medical care facility as defined in K.S.A. 65-425, and
27 amendments thereto, except that "~~patient~~**{licensed}** care facility" includes
28 a hospice that is certified to participate in the medicare program under 42
29 C.F.R. § 418.1 et seq.

30 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
31 publication in the statute book.
