1 A RESOLUTION affirming state sovereignty, supporting Texas in its  
2 efforts to combat illegal immigration and encouraging Governor Laura  
3 Kelly to offer the services of the Kansas National Guard to the state of  
4 Texas.

6 WHEREAS, Section 4 of Article IV of the United States Constitution  
7 requires the federal government to protect the states against invasion;  
8 and

9 WHEREAS, Since the beginning of the Biden administration, millions of  
10 illegal immigrants have crossed the southern border of the United  
11 States, especially through Texas; and

12 WHEREAS, Under the current administration, the federal government  
13 has failed to protect the country from what has become an invasion  
14 and has encouraged the increase in illegal immigration by prohibiting  
15 Texas from defending its border; and

16 WHEREAS, Section 10, clause 3 of Article I of the United States  
17 Constitution allows for the states to enter into agreements in the face  
18 of an actual invasion: Now, therefore,

19 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas:*  
20 That we offer the support of the state of Kansas to the state of Texas in  
21 defending its southern border from the invasion of illegal immigrants  
22 and from the refusal of the federal government to secure such border;  
23 and

24 *Be it further resolved:* That we encourage Governor Laura Kelly to  
25 provide the Governor of Texas any support she deems necessary,  
26 including, but not limited to, the Kansas National Guard, Kansas law  
27 enforcement agents, equipment and supplies; and

28 *Be it further resolved:* That we seek further conversations with the  
29 Governor and the Legislature of the state of Texas to formalize an  
30 agreement of support and solidarity against future lawlessness by

1       illegal immigrants and the detrimental actions or nonactions of the  
2       federal government; and  
3       *Be it further resolved:* That the Chief Clerk of the House of  
4       Representatives shall send an enrolled copy of this resolution to Texas  
5       Governor, Greg Abbott, Texas House Speaker, Dade Phelan, Governor  
6       Laura Kelly and Representatives Hawkins and Proctor.
