SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2210

As Recommended by House Committee on Veterans and Military

Brief*

HB 2210 would amend law governing the appointment of Kansas Army and Air National Guard officers. Under current law, the Governor appoints and commissions general officers who are then subject to confirmation by the Kansas Senate. The bill would remove the requirement that general officers be confirmed by the Senate.

Background

The bill was introduced by the House Committee on Veterans and Military at the request of a representative of the Adjutant General's Department.

House Committee on Veterans and Military

In the House Committee hearing on February 7, 2023, a representative of the Adjutant General's Department testified as a **proponent** of the bill, stating that the current confirmation requirement could lead to delays and confusion regarding the promotion of an officer. Removing the Senate confirmation requirement for general officers would allow for more efficiency and flexibility within the Adjutant General's Department.
