SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 333

As Amended by Senate Committee on Commerce

Brief*

SB 333 would extend the sunset date for the State Use Law Committee, which is organized within the Department of Administration, to July 1, 2029.

[*Note*: Under current law, the State Use Law Committee is set to sunset on July 1, 2024.]

Background

The bill was introduced by the Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs at the request of Senator Faust-Goudeau.

Senate Committee on Commerce

In the Senate Committee hearing, **proponent** testimony was provided by representatives of the Cerebral Palsy Research Foundation of Kansas and Envision. Proponents generally stated the Kansas State Use Law encourages state and local units of government to support adults with disabilities to find and sustain employment, and the State Use Law Committee brings together stakeholders to collaborate on ways to improve this process.

The Senate Committee amended the bill to extend the sunset provision for five years.
