Chairman Cox said the committee would work HB 2723 - Manufactured homes and mobile homes; certificate of titles.

Dr. Wolff pointed out that there had been a proposed amendment on page 2, line 36, to remove "division" and insert "county treasurer."

Representative Sharp made a motion to make this amendment to HB2723. Representative Burroughs seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Representative Sharp made a motion to pass out HB2723 as amended. Representative Toelkes seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Chairman Cox said the committee would work HB 2807 - Consumer protection, method of payment authorization.

Representative Gatewood made a motion to pass out HB 2807 favorably. Representative Merrick seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Representative Cox said the committee would work HB 2812 - UCCC, balloon payment, exception.

Dr. Wolff said there was a proposed amendment to delete "a certificate of title in" on page 1, line 26.

Representative Minor made a motion to make this amendment to HB 2812. Representative Dreher seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Representative Grant made a motion to pass out HB2812 favorably for passage as amended. Representative Toelkes seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Representative Cox said the committee would work HB 2813 - Real estate sales validation questionnaires; use of.

Representative Dreher made a motion to pass out HB 2813 favorably. Representative Sharp seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Chairman Cox presented the committee minutes for February 6 and February 13, 2002 for approval.

Representative Grant made a motion to approve the committee minutes for February 6th and February 13th as written. Representative Merrick seconded the motion. The motion carried.
